

AGREEMENT

Walk the New Refugee Route into Greece

This agreement is between Refugee Support Europe ('RSE') and you and relates to your participation in our Walk the New Refugee Route in Greece event ('the event')

ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for the event you must:

- complete the registration form and immediately pay £100 non-refundable deposit towards your accommodation and subsistence costs during the event; and
- pay for the remaining accommodation and subsistence costs (capped at an additional £400 although we will be aiming to charge less than that); and
- raise an additional minimum of £1,500 for RSE

You will only be entitled to take part in the event if:

- RSE receives from you £100 on registration; and
- you are sufficiently fit and healthy to take part in the event without serious risk to your health and safety or the health and safety of others; and
- RSE is satisfied that your participation in the event is not likely to have a detrimental effect on the morale of the participants as a whole so as to make it likely that other participants will fail to complete the event; and
- you have taken out comprehensive travel insurance

FUNDRAISING

You agree that you will raise £1,500 for RSE and you will use all reasonable endeavours to collect and send this and all additional funds pledged either in cash, by cheque or added to an online fundraising page within 4 weeks after the end of the event

You agree that in carrying out all fundraising you will comply with the following requirements:

- You will abide by any fundraising guidelines issued by us from time to time;
- You will only use lawful means to fundraise and must not do anything which harms or is likely to harm the charity's reputation;
- When asking for money from potential sponsors you will make it clear that the cost of your participation in the event will be paid out of the money raised
- When asking for money from potential sponsors, you will make it clear that their sponsorship will be paid for the benefit of the charity and will not be refundable even if the event does not take place or you do not take part in it or you do not complete it; and

ACCOMMODATION AND SUBSISTENCE COSTS

You will need to pay for your own travel to Thessaloniki where the event will start and return travel from Thessaloniki to your onward destination

Accommodation and subsistence costs will be capped at £400 on top of the registration fee and you will be told the final cost no less than two months before departure. Full must be made four weeks prior to departure.

CHANGES TO THE ITINERARY AND CANCELLATION

We will use all reasonable endeavours to ensure that the event takes place so far as reasonably possible in accordance with the information provided in the event brochure and website. However, we may make such alterations to the arrangements as they may reasonably require, including (for example) changes to the anticipated departure date and return date by up to two days either side of those dates, changes to the itinerary and changes to the proposed accommodation.

We reserve the right to cancel the event at any time before the departure date and in particular to cancel if fewer than 15 participants become eligible to take part.

Completing your registration form signifies your agreement to abide by the authority of the leader, who represents RSE. The decision of the leader as to the conduct, itinerary and objectives of the tour is final. If in the opinion of the leader, your behaviour or physical condition is detrimental to the safety, welfare and wellbeing of the group as a whole or that your general well-being will be put at risk by continuing, you may be asked to leave the tour without the right to any refund for unused services.

You hereby irrevocably assign to the charity all rights you may now or in the future have to receive such compensation and/or refunds in relation to the event. If you choose not to participate in the event or if the event is cancelled or if you do not become eligible to take part in the event or if we prevent you from doing so, all sums collected or pledged will still be payable to the charity. However, we will refund the registration fee if we cancel the event or if we prevent you from taking part; the registration fee is not refundable in any other circumstances.

If you wish to cancel, notice must be received in writing from you and will be taken from the date received. In all cases you will lose the registration fee.

DATA PROTECTION

Photography and filming may take place during the event to be used as promotional material for RSE. Please inform RSE if you do not wish to feature.

By taking part in this event you give us your explicit consent to share your data with service providers who provide local support services relevant to your chosen event

GENERAL

This agreement constitutes the entire agreement and understanding between us and you relating to the event and supersedes all other prior representations, agreements, or arrangements whether written or oral, express or implied relating to the event.

This agreement is governed by English law and you and we irrevocably submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of the English courts.

By completing and signing the application form to take part in the event, you agree to be bound by these conditions.

LIABILITY

By paying the £100 deposit, you realise and accept the hazards involved in this type of tour, including injury or death, disease, loss or damage to property, and that you come on the tour at your own risk. Other than liability for negligence in respect of death or personal injury, we accept no liability for any injury resulting from the hazards of trekking or any other activity included in the itinerary, or for any other mishaps to yourself or your property, and in particular as a consequence of flight cancellations, strikes, wars, riots, sickness or other such happenings. Any independent travel arrangements that you make are also at your own risk.

You travel, together with your personal property including baggage, solely at your own risk at all times. You are wholly responsible for arranging your own insurance. We require proof of cover no less than one month before departure. We reserve the right to refuse participation without proof of insurance.
