We go to places where refugees are first arriving, then quickly set up the vital services and distributions that are needed





We are a professionally-led volunteer organisation that cares about refugee welfare



What do we do?

Identify what newly arrived refugees and asylum seekers need and fill that gap



Set up and run Dignity Centres (with safe spaces, activities, learning)

Distribute essential items for a more dignified life





Offer short term food security in emergencies



How do we deliver services?

Volunteers will be led by professional, salaried coordinators



Volunteers will be the core of our workforce and we will pay coordinators to maintain consistency



We co-operate and partner with other organisations to distribute items and deliver services



After handing over control of services to a new organisation we will stay on as advisor/ trustee



Where will we work?

We go to places where refugees are first arriving

Greece: Phase out the free food shop and set up an activity that we can hand over





Cyprus: Set up and run Dignity Centres offering activities to relieve boredom and get skills
